

# Instructions for Preparation of Papers for the Proceedings of NetCod 2008

## I. INTRODUCTION

The Fourth Workshop on Network Coding, Theory, and Applications (NetCod 2008) will be held on January 3 and 4, 2008 at The Chinese University of Hong Kong. The workshop URL is

## II. PROCEEDINGS

All papers accepted for oral and poster presentation will be published in the workshop proceedings (in both printing and CDROM forms) provided that at least one author pre-registers for the workshop. The papers will also be included in the IEEEExplore online database and indexed by Engineering Index (Ei).

The deadline for workshop pre-registration (FREE) and submission of the final manuscript and the signed IEEE copyright form is **November 19, 2007**.

## III. PREPARATION OF THE PAPER

Only electronic submissions in the form of Portable Document Format (PDF) file will be accepted (**Note: it is very important to use A4 size paper, and not to show page numbers**). Authors are encouraged to use L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X to format their final manuscripts.

The L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X style file (`NetCod08.sty`) and the L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X source (`NetCod08_Example.tex`) that produced this page may be downloaded from the workshop web site. Authors using other means to prepare their manuscripts should attempt to duplicate the style of this example as closely as possible.

The paper length is limited to 6 pages. The **Abstract** section should not exceed 250 words.

The style of references, e.g., [1], equations, figures, tables, etc., should be the same as for the *IEEE Transactions on Information Theory*. The affiliation shown for authors should constitute a sufficient mailing address.

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## IV. SUBMISSION OF FINAL MANUSCRIPT AND IEEE COPYRIGHT FORM
